1. Berliner Weisse

White Birch Brewing Company - Hookset, NH
5.5% ABV. Bottles, draft. Available: June-September

Napoleon's troops referred to Berliner Weisse as the "Champagne of the North" due to its lively and elegant character. Today this style is described by some as the most refreshing beer in the world. Our approach was to brew this beer with *Lactobacillus* for a refreshing and authentic interpretation of a classic summer refresher.

2. Sensory Series V.1 – Lower Dens

Stillwater Artisanal Ales – Baltimore, MD
6% ABV. Brewed once. Bottles, draft.
Ale brewed with hibiscus

Named after a 4-piece group from Baltimore, Maryland. Their most recent album, *Nootropics*, was released in May of 2012 on Ribbon Music. (Ryan's observation: They look like the nihilists from the *Big Lebowski*)

"The Stillwater Sensory Series is a collaboration between Stillwater Artisanal and singular musical artists. In this first collaboration, Stillwater works with Lower Dens to make an ale based on an interpretation of their song, "In the End is the Beginning." On the bottle itself, a QR code will link to an exclusive Lower Dens performance of the song. Ultimately, this is a true artistic collaboration that aims to create a full sensory experience - sound, sight, smell, touch, and taste."

4. Tandem

Belgian style Dubbel
Pike Brewing – Seattle, WA
7.5% ABV. 25 IBUs. Year-round. Bottles, draft.
Hops: Northern Brewer & Mount Hood. Malts: Pale, Crystal, Munich, Wheat, & Roasted.

Monks originally marked double ales with 2 ts. Our Double is named for the Finkel's bicycle.

3. Jack D'Or

American Saison
Pretty Things Beer & Ale Project – Westport, MA
6.5% ABV. 57 IBUs. Year-round. Bottles, draft.
Hops: Nugget, Styrian Golding, Columbus & Palisade.
Malts: Pils, Vienna, Wheat, Oats, Rye. No spices or sugar added.

"Jack D'Or" is a simple table beer, or "Saison American" as we're referring to it. We are not trying to coin a beer style - we're just having fun. The Jack D'Or (pronounced "Jack Door"), is at the very center of Pretty Things and nearly three years on we're still pleased as punch that he joined us! Jack D'Or is the kind of beer Martha and Dann like to drink before, after and during a great meal. Heck, we'll drink this sort of beer any time.

5. Funky Galaxy

Prairie Artisan Ales – Krebs, OK
7% ABV. Bottles, draft. Rotating availability.

A Galaxy hopped black farmhouse ale

6. Alpha King

American Pale Ale
Three Floyds – Munster, IN
6.66% ABV. 68 IBU. Year-round. Bottles, draft.
Hops: Centennial, Cascade, & Warrior.

3 Floyd's flagship beer, Alpha King is a big American pale ale that pours a deep amber with a creamy head. This ale is brewed with Centennial, Cascade, and Warrior hops giving it an intense citrus aroma and a crisp hoppy finish.
